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PROGRAM DESCRIPTION



DAY 1: Welcome to Galapagos! We will make of this trip an unforgettable experience!

The Airport is located at Baltra Island. Upon your arrival, you must go to the Immigration Counter to register your visit and pay for the National Park entrance fee –USD cash only; preferably no \$100 bills. Then you can proceed to pick up and scan your luggage and head for the exit to meet with our representative.

Your first visit will be the Primicias' Ranch, a private property where you'll be surprised by the giant tortoises, and you'll also have the opportunity to explore the 400m lava tunnels. This visit has an approximate duration of three hours.

Meals included: Lunch.

DAY 2. Navigable tour to one island: With ten days in advance we will confirm you to which island you will visit, as well as the pick-up time from your hotel. This tour as an estimated duration of 8 hours.

Meals included: Breakfast and box lunch.

DAY 3. This day we have to leave the hotel very early in order to be at the harbor at six thirty in the morning for the mandatory luggage screening before boarding the public ferry that after two hours of navigation will take you to Puerto Villamil (Isabella Is.). A short boat ride will take you at Las Tintoreras Islet with its shallow lava channel; you'll have an easy walk to observe the white tipped reef sharks, iguanas, rays, sea lions, marine turtles, among other species. This visit has an approximate duration of one hour and forty five minutes.

Meals included: Breakfast; lunch at a local restaurant.



DAY 4. This day we'll also have to leave the hotel quite early, at about seven in the morning. We'll take a forty five minutes bus ride, and after that we'll have a four to six hours hike (*please wear appropriate shoes and clothes for this excursion, and be prepared for the terrain's rocky and sandy conditions; the duration may vary depending on weather conditions, the participants physical conditions, etc.).*

After this impressive visit, you'll have a box lunch and will have some time for resting before heading back.

<u>Important</u>: This program is particularly recommended for intermediate to advanced hikers. Please keep in mind that the crater may be foggy and the view can be limited.

Estimated duration: Eight hours.

Meals included: Breakfast and box lunch.



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DAY 5: We must leave the hotel at five thirty in the morning in order to take the six o'clock ferry to Puerto Ayora. Again, this is two hour navigation. Depending on your flight arrangements, you may or may not have time for breakfast, or may have a breakfast to go. Transfer to Baltra Airport.

Meals included: Light breakfast.

What-to-pack recommendations

- Good walking shoes; slippers
- At least one litter of water per person for the volcanoes excursion
- Rain coat -especially if traveling between August and October
- Light, casual, cotton based clothing; long sleeves shirts
- Shorts
- **Swimsuit**
- Hat
- **Binoculars**
- Sunglasses
- Sun block, minimum 30UV of protection
- Bugs repellent
- Plastic bag to protect your equipment(s)
- Camera
- Wet suit –especially if traveling between July and November.







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
